24.265 RESOLUTION TO CLOSE THE MEETING TO THE PUBLIC	
a. Councillors resolved to close the meeting to the public.	
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24.266 HANDOVER OF THE SPORTS PAVILION	
a. Councillors noted receipt of the building control sign-off and building manuals and	
resolved to agree handover (but are still waiting for the architect's certification before	
it can be finally completed).	
<b>b.</b> The councillors could not agree to the final payment and retention as Turnquay have	
failed to confirm the clerk's figures or send their own after two weeks of asking, and	
then sent contradictory figures (with obvious errors) a few minutes before the	
meeting. Items disputed are the soil survey cost, the dwarf wall cost and the	
methodology to calculate the retention (which involves double counting). The clerk will	Clerk
deal with these matters after the meeting.	
c. Councillors reviewed the previous list of snagging items. Of the items still of concern,	
councillors agreed to not pursue the broken drain cover and will deal with it	
themselves at a later date. The only issue still to be raised is the door knobs on	
cupboards. The garage doors will be reviewed at a later date during the 3-month	
retention period but not raised today.	
<b>d.</b> All councillors at this meeting agreed to attend the handover meeting.	
e. Councillors agreed to split out the work load getting in quotes with Cllr Smith agreeing	Smith/
to get carpet quotes and Cllr Quinlan getting electrician quotes. Cllr Smith volunteered	Quinlan
someone to paint the stair rail. The sports club equipment will need to stay in the	
container the until picnic tables are installed and out of the way.	

There were no further matters to discuss and the meeting was closed at 2.30pm.
